**Welcome and thank you for choosing to study Co-production in Health and Welfare this Autumn at Jönköping University (JU).**

The course is an online, part-time distance course which is given at quarter speed throughout the autumn semester (approximately 10 hours per week). It is designed for those completely new to the topic of co-production with optional advanced content for those with experience in the subject. JU use Canvas as learning platform. The course is available on Canvas week 34, August 2026. **Notice! This welcome letter has 2 pages!** Please read it thoroughly to ensure all steps in the introduction process for the course.

**1. Activate your JU user account:**

The first step is accepting your seat. Please do so latest by 19<sup>th</sup> of July on [Antagning.se](https://antagning.se). One week before start of the course you must create your student account. Please use this link: <https://activation.ju.se/loginselector> so that you can log into Canvas. If you have not been given any information about registering as a student at Jönköping University, please contact me so that I can assist you with this. **2. Register on Ladok**

Once you have set up your JU account, [info about Ladok for students - please register to get access to Canvas learning platform and grading system](#). Registration will be possible from one week before start of the course.

**The course will start week 35 with a mandatory meeting on Thursday August 27<sup>th</sup>.**

We start at 15.00 – for a short introduction (end at approx. 16.30). If you for some reason cannot attend – please get in contact with course coordinator ASAP to ensure your position. The first week you will have self-guided study, including reading and publish a short presentation of yourself in the course. This will prepare you for our first live session/webinar in Zoom together on Friday September 4, 2026.

Throughout, your course will take place entirely online via the Canvas learning platform and Zoom so you do not need to travel to Jönköping University for live seminars or meetings.
