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Printing documents in color from a MAC

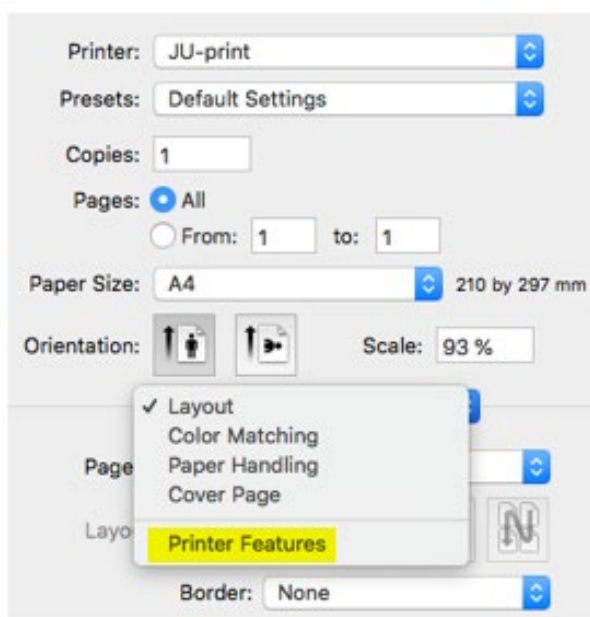
To print documents in color, you first need to configure a preset in your printer settings.

You do this by opening a PDF file using the Preview tool.

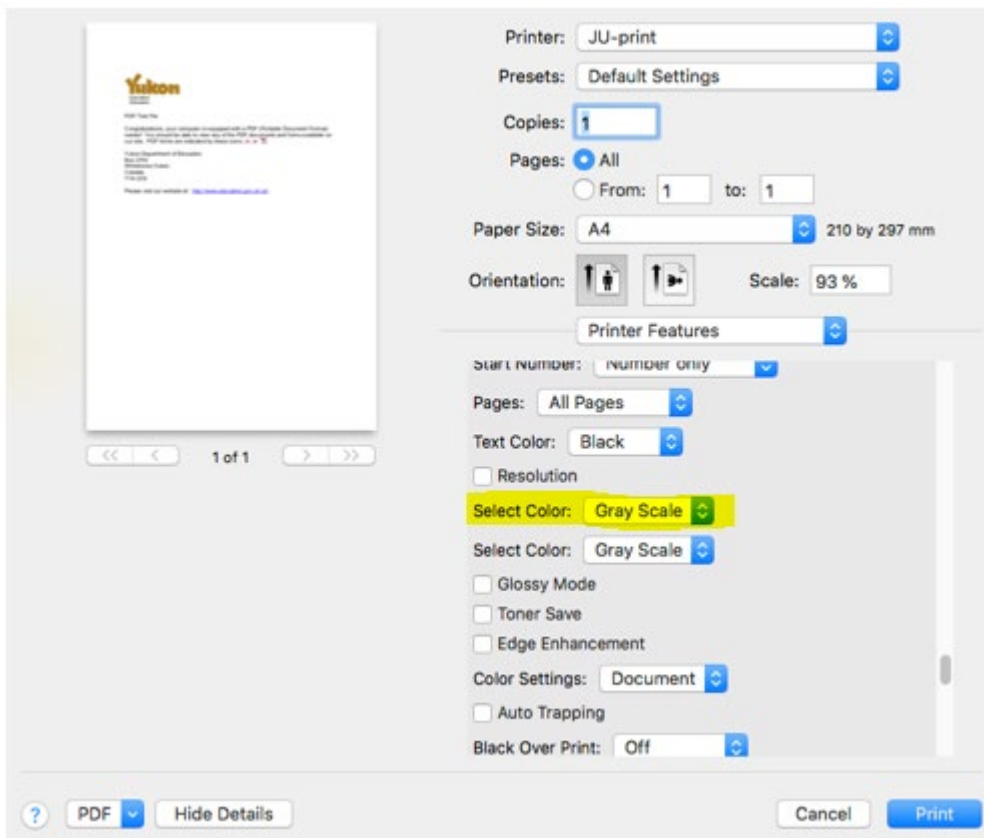
Then, select the option to print the PDF, however, before clicking Print, you need to configure a preset for color printing.

The setting is not saved automatically, so you must create a new "Preset" by following these instructions:

1. Switch from Layout to Printer Features.

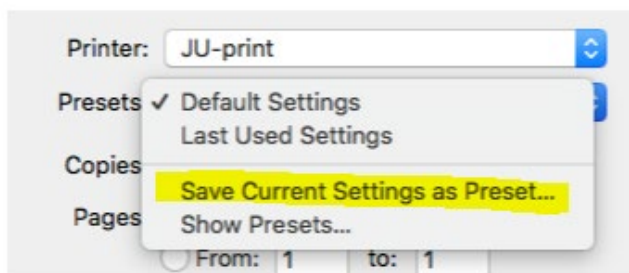


2. Then switch from Gray Scale to Auto Color under Select Color, as shown in the image below.

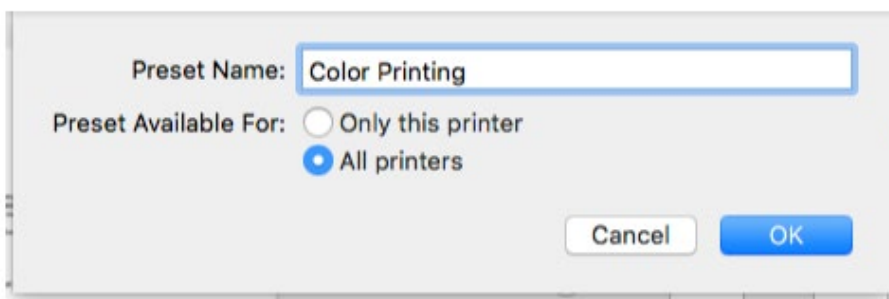


3. You then need to save the setting so that you can select it for the next print job.

Select Presets and then Save Current Settings as Preset...



4. You can then give the saved setting a name of your choice.



Then, simply switch the preset to the desired print setting, whether you want to print using the default settings or the color configuration you have just set up.
